



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF RAILWAY STREET, BALBRIGGAN, CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received from GMC Utilities Group Ltd on behalf of Gas Networks Ireland for permission to temporarily close Railway Street, Balbriggan, Co. Dublin for the purpose of a domestic gas service connection. It is proposed that the road will be closed from **8.00am to 6.00pm on Tuesday 21st May 2024**.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic to continue straight on Georges Hill, turn right onto Main Street - Drogheda Street, turn right onto Railway Street. End of Detour. Approx 300m

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
