

ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023– SECTION 75 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CHURCH ROAD, SWORDS, CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received from GMC Utilities on behalf of Uisce Eireann for permission to temporarily close **Church Road, Swords, Co. Dublin** for the purpose of investigation of defect on carriageway and repair of reinstatement. It is proposed that the road will be closed on the **27th of May 2024 to 28th of May 2024 for 24 hours per day.**

Permitted working hours shall be between 07:00hrs to 19:00hrs Monday to Friday.

No works shall take place on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays.

Alternative route available for vehicular traffic is as follows;

From Dublin Road – Traffic coming from Dublin Road, turn left onto Brackenstown Road, continue to junction of Brackenstown Avenue, turn left onto Brackenstown Avenue, continue on Brackenstown Avenue to Rathbeale Road.

From Brackenstown – Traffic coming from Brackenstown turn left onto Brackenstown Avenue, continue on Brackenstown Avenue to Rathbeale Road.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency Services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
